

Directions to EcoVillage of Loudoun County

TRAVELING FROM DC METRO AREA IN VIRGINIA

- You can reach EcoVillage by traveling on Route 7 or the Dulles Toll Road.
- At Leesburg, take Route 15N/Leesburg Bypass to Frederick, MD. The 4-lanes will eventually become 2-lanes.
- From the stop light (the only one) in the village of Lucketts, you will travel 4.4 miles. Then turn left on Lovettsville Road/672. This is a sharp left turn and can be easily missed. Where you turn left, Route 15 curves sharply to the right. There are flashing overhead lights as you approach this turn. Lovettsville Road is a narrow country road.
- If you miss the left turn to Lovettsville Road/672, you will cross the bridge over the Potomac River to Maryland. If this happens, take the first right on Route 12 to Point of Rocks to turn around and head back on Route 15S. Once back over the bridge, you will take an immediate sharp right on Lovettsville Road/672.
- After turning on Lovettsville Road/672, you will travel 2.7 miles, and then turn left on Taylorstown Road/668. This is at the top of a steep hill and just after Yakey road to the left. These two roads are close together.
- After turning left on Taylorstown Road/668, you will travel 0.9 miles, and then turn left on Hickory Shade Lane into the EcoVillage. This is the main entrance to our community.
- The road before this one is Meadow Vista on the left, which leads to a small housing community. Hickory Shade Lane is a gravel road. Please stay within the 10 mph speed limit. **Note:** On Hickory Shade Lane, all houses on the right are part of our EcoVillage. Those on the left are part of a different community.
- You will travel about half a mile on Hickory Shade Lane. Then you will reach Trillium Glen Lane on the left. Because of limited street parking on Trillium Glen Lane, we ask that you park in the community parking areas off of Hickory Shade Lane.

TRAVELING FROM DC METRO AREA IN MARYLAND

(1) Scenic Option from Frederick to the EcoVillage

- From Maryland, you can reach EcoVillage by traveling on Route 270N from the Beltway.
- At Frederick, take Route 85S/Buckeystown Pike, which takes you through scenic country and farmland.
- Turn right at Route 12W/Tuscarora Road to Point of Rocks. **Note:** Route 85S is mostly a two lane road but widens to a third lane just before this turn.
- Turn left at Route 15S at the last stop light in Point of Rocks.

- Immediately after you cross the bridge over the Potomac River to Virginia, you will take a sharp right on Lovettsville Road/672.
- After turning on Lovettsville Road/672, you will travel 2.7 miles, and then turn left on Taylorstown Road/668. This is at the top of a steep hill and just after Yakey road to the left. These two roads are close together.
- After turning left on Taylorstown Road/668, you will travel 0.9 miles, and then turn left on Hickory Shade Lane into the EcoVillage. This is the main entrance to our community.
- The road before this one is Meadow Vista on the left, which leads to a small housing community. Hickory Shade Lane is a gravel road. Please stay within the 10 mph speed limit. **Note:** On Hickory Shade Lane, all houses on the right are part of our EcoVillage. Those on the left are part of a different community.
- You will travel about half a mile on Hickory Shade Lane. Then you will reach Trillium Glen Lane on the left. Because of limited street parking on Trillium Glen Lane, we ask that you park in the community parking areas off of Hickory Shade Lane.

(2) Alternative Option

- Take Route 270N to 15S at Frederick. Note: You will often veer left to stay on 15S. So you may want to stay in the left lane.
- Route 15S takes you to VA. The last town in MD before you cross into VA is Point of Rocks. Immediately after you cross the bridge over the Potomac River to Virginia, you will take a sharp right on Lovettsville Road/672.
- After turning on Lovettsville Road/672, you will travel 2.7 miles, and then turn left on Taylorstown Road/668. This is at the top of a steep hill and just after Yakey road to the left. These two roads are close together.
- After turning left on Taylorstown Road/668, you will travel 0.9 miles, and then turn left on Hickory Shade Lane into the EcoVillage. This is the main entrance to our community.
- The road before this one is Meadow Vista on the left, which leads to a small housing community. Hickory Shade Lane is a gravel road.
